## INIT in the US

INIT is providing Gold Coast Transit (GCT) from California with its MOBILE-PLAN advanced scheduling solution for their fixed-route fleet. The software should assist GCT in creating efficient schedule plans and better allocating its resources. The contract with the operator calls for 12 workstation licenses and a Google Transit Export feature, as well as creating rosters, bidding and timekeeping software (PERDIS), which will assist GCT to efficiently schedule



and manage drivers.

INIT claim its MOBILE-PLAN will

optimally design schedules, blocks and runs for GCT's fixed-route fleet. The operator runs 39 vehicles with 100 drivers on 23 routes, but the agency expects to double its staff over the next ten years and expand to 125 vehicles or more by 2021. The software's optimisation algorithm will generate cost saving schedules.
